Joseph Phelps, Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast, CA 2014 20 / 80

Ripe Golden Delicious apple and Bartlett pear, kettle corn and hazelnut. Full and round with a luscious mid-palate and a clean, refreshing finish.

Maison L' Envoye, Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, OR 20 / 80

Dark red cherry, ripe red plum, lavender, fennel and dried herbs. Beautiful body and structure, with a Burgundian feel. Juicy mid-palate with a touch of oak and a long, lingering finish.

Domaine Roger Perrin, Grenache blend, Châteauneuf-Du-Pape, FR 2014 30 / 120

Blended with Syrah and Mourvedre. Ripe red cherries and raspberries with toasted oats and vanilla. Hints of red rose petals and a slightly dusty, herbaceous finish.

Ronchi, Nebbiolo, Barbaresco, Piemonte, Italy 2013 18 / 72

Dark red cherry, dried purple plum and fig with hints of licorice, earth and tobacco. Medium to full bodied with chewy fruit tannin and a long, lingering finish.

Musella, Corvino blend, Valpolicella Della Amarone, Veneto, Italy 2011 25 / 100

Blended with Corvinone. Dried red cherry, red plum, strawberry licorice, bay leaf, fennel and spice. Full and rich on the palate, with firm tannin and a long, dry finish.

Justin, Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles, CA 2015 20 / 80

Dark berry fruit showing black currant and blackberry, dark plum and a hint of tobacco on the nose and palate. Full and round with pronounced fruit tannin and a long finish.

Paul Hobbs, "Cross Barn", Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, CA 2014 30 / 120

A classic, full-bodied Cab from the legendary Paul Hobbs. Dark red and purple fruit, with blueberry, blackberry, cassis and a hint of licorice. Tannic and juicy, with a long and balanced finish.

High West Campfire - 92 proof
