**Joseph Phelps, Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast, CA 2014** 20 / 80  
*Ripe Golden Delicious apple and Bartlett pear, kettle corn and hazelnut. Full and round with a luscious mid-palate and a clean, refreshing finish.*

**Brewer Clifton, Pinot Noir, Santa Rita Hills, CA 2015** 25 / 100  
*A true Burgundian approach to California Pinot Noir. Aromas of vine-ripened strawberry and raspberry with notes of damp earth and flower petals. On the palate, dried red fruits and star anise, with a long, elegant finish.*

**Ermanno Costa, Nebbiolo, Roero DOCG, Piemonte, Italy 2014** 18 / 72  
*Dried red cherry and licorice, with hints of red rose petal, spearmint, leaf tobacco, mushroom and hay. Firm tannin on the palate with a dry and earthy finish.*

**Ronchi, Nebbiolo, Barbaresco, Piemonte, Italy 2014** 20 / 80  
*Dark red cherry, dried purple plum and fig with hints of licorice, earth and tobacco. Medium to full bodied with chewy fruit tannin and a long, lingering finish.*

**Justin, Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles, CA 2015** 20 / 80  
*Dark berry fruit showing black currant and blackberry, dark plum and a hint of tobacco on the nose and palate. Full and round with pronounced fruit tannin and a long finish.*

**Domaine Roger Perrin, Grenache blend, Châteauneuf-Du-Pape, FR 2015** 30 / 120  
*Blended with Syrah and Mourvedre. Ripe red cherries and raspberries with toasted oats and vanilla. Hints of red rose petals and a slightly dusty, herbaceous finish.*

**Musella, Corvina blend, Valpolicella Della Amarone, Veneto, Italy 2012** 30 / 120  
*Blended with Corvinone. Dried red cherry, red plum, strawberry licorice, bay leaf, fennel and spice. Full and rich on the palate, with firm tannin and a long, dry finish.*

**Prisoner, Zinfandel Blend, Napa Valley, CA 2017** 25 / 100  
*Blended with Cabernet Sauvignon and Petite Sirah. This wine was inspired by Italian immigrants who originally settled in Napa. Rich and luscious with notes of blackberry and boysenberry, fig, dark chocolate and vanilla. Full bodied with velvety tannin and a long, finish.*

**Paul Hobbs, "Cross Barn", Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, CA 2015** 30 / 120  
*A classic, full-bodied Cab from the legendary Paul Hobbs. Dark red and purple fruit, with blueberry, blackberry, cassis and a hint of licorice. Tannic and juicy, with a long and balanced finish.*

### Identity Crisis – Mixed 16

#### Woodford Bourbon | Bulleit Rye | Benromach 10 Year Scotch

*Are you just getting started with whiskey and want to find out your preference: Bourbon, Rye or Scotch? The main difference is the grain used: corn vs. rye vs. barley. This flight will help you establish your whiskey identity.*

**Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing:** Ciccio or Farmhouse Cheddar

### Burden of Proof – Bourbon 16

**Basil Hayden's (80 proof) | Buffalo Trace (90 proof) | Noah's Mill (114 proof)**  
*Different techniques of distillation can result in different levels of alcohol content. The 'heat' is greater with the higher alcohol content bourbons, giving them a more robust flavor. Lighter proof bourbons tend to be smoother and more delicate.*

**Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing:** Boar Salami or Zimbro Casa Lusa

### Ryes to the Occasion – Rye 16

#### Michter's Rye | Templeton Small Batch | High West Double Rye

*The subtle difference in the taste of Ryes are based on the percentage rye (70%/ 80%/ 98% respectively), the location of the distillery and the distillation process (traditional pot distillation vs. modern distillation that is filtered more).*

**Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing:** Rabbit Pate or Ossau-Iraty

### Age Dilemma – Scotch 24

#### Caol Ila 10 Yr | Macallan 12 Yr | Linkwood 15 Yr

*Aging has a big impact in flavor profile. Younger scotches tend to have more of a strong, firm palate, while older selections get smoother, adding layers of fragrance like cinnamon, clove, and peat.*

### Hop Scotch – Single Malt Whiskey 32

#### Westland American | Kaiyo Mizunara | Lagavulin 16 Year

*It's not a real scotch unless it's made in Scotland. Or is it? Well, the Americans and Japanese take exception to that and here's their response. The water in each country ultimately makes the difference in flavor. See for yourself.*
