### The Bay's Finest – Mixed 17

**Lost Republic Bourbon | Wright and Brown Rye | 10<sup>th</sup> Street STR**  
*Great whiskey is right in your own backyard. Try this mixed flight if you're only beginning to taste whiskey or looking for local expressions. These whiskies are made respectively in Healdsburg, Oakland and downtown San Jose!*  
**Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing:** Ciccicoli or Landaff by Jasper Hill

### Against the Grain – Bourbon 15

**Elijah Craig (High Corn)| Larceny (Wheated)| Four Roses Small Batch (High Rye)**  
*By law Bourbon must contain at least 51% percent corn in its mash, but what makes up the other 49 percent? Rye, Malted Barley and Wheat are all used in combination to create unique bourbon expressions. The following whiskies take you on a tour of standard, wheated and high rye bourbons.*  
**Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing:** Tasso Ham or Serra de Esetrella

### Ryes to the Occasion – Rye 15

**Sazerac (50-60% Rye) | Bulleit (95% Rye, 5% Malted Barley)| Woodinville (100% Rye)**  
*Just as bourbon is required to contain 51% corn by volume, Rye is required to contain 51% rye. The distiller may choose to blend in corn or malted barley for balance or simply use all rye. Find out your preferred style of Rye!*  
**Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing:** Rabbit Pate or Ossau-Iraty

### Age Dilemma – Scotch 25

**Bladnoch 10 | Deanston 12 | Glencadam 15**  
*Aging has a big impact in flavor profile. Younger scotches tend to have more of a strong, firm palate, while older selections get smoother, adding layers of fragrance like cinnamon, and clove. The following whiskies are all aged exclusively in ex-bourbon barrels.*  
**Cheese & Charcuterie Pairing:** Rilletes or Cabricharme

### For Peat's Sake – Peated Single Malt Whiskies 22

**Kilkerran 12 | Kilchoman | Bruchladdich Port Charlotte 10**  
*One of the most interesting and polarizing flavors in some Scotch whisky is peat. Hickory smoke, iodine, charcoal, and brine are only a few of the unique flavors from these whiskies. Not all Scotch is peated equally, however. See if you can survive until the end of this increasingly smokey journey.*

### Whistle Pig – Rye 42

**10 Year Straight | 12 Year Old World | 15 Year Straight**  
*One rye is 100 proof and aged in bourbon barrels. Another is 86 proof and aged in 63% madera, 30% Sauternes and 7% Port barrels. The third rye is 92 proof and aged in new Vermont oak grown on Whistle Pig's property. Can you tell which is which?*

### High West – Mixed 16

**American Prairie | Double Rye | Campfire**  
*One master distiller playing with all 3 grains (corn, rye and barley). One is a bourbon, the other rye and the third, a blend of bourbon, scotch and rye. It takes a distiller from Utah to do something crazy like that.*

### Compass Box – Scotch Blend 25

**Hedonism | Great King Street | The Peat Monster**  
*Compass Box is an American distiller that went over to Scotland using the highest American standards for whiskey making (don't tell that to the Scots). These 3 expressions of scotch range from smooth to smoky/peaty.*

### Wright & Brown – Mixed 22

**Bourbon | Rye | Rum**  
*From local Oakland producer Wright & Brown, this distillery became Oakland's first since Prohibition! Specializing in non-GMO grains (local and organic when possible) these guys do all the right things with their classic interpretations.*

### Fortaleza – Tequila

**Blanco | Reposado (6 Months) | Anejo (18 Months)**  
*Fortaleza is a single distiller dedicated to one brand in the Los Valles region of Jalisco. These tequilas are handcrafted with old fashioned authentic traditions. Agave is cooked in clay brick ovens. A stone "Tahona" crushes the 8 year old plants for their nectar. Double distillation occurs in old school copper pot stills. And aging is done in exclusively American oak barrels.*
